



What can my pledge be spent on?

All gifts will be held in a separate bank account and, as a restricted fund, can only be used for this project as laid out in the planning documents and cannot be spent elsewhere.

When do I give the money I pledge?

You may give one-off gifts straight away and we have already begun to receive regular donations. If you need a standing order form, please let us know, but our annexe fund bank details are over the page.

Unless permission is given, we will not spend this money until important milestones are reached.

So far £258,000 has been given/pledged. A further £429,000* through gifts, grants and loans is needed to enable the project to be completed in full.

We have passed the first milestone (1/3 of total cost), so technical / engineering designs are being drawn up, along with necessary ground investigations.

Once £86,000 more is raised, 50% of the total costs projected by the Quantity Surveyor will have been covered. This will help us access numerous external grant making bodies, e.g. the Rank Foundation.

If you are involved with a local business and wish to sponsor a specific part with materials, e.g. flooring, kitchen units, paint, etc. please do get in touch.

Why Pledge?

Knowing what people intend to give means we can take decisions about completing the project with confidence as milestones are reached.

If loans are required, longer term pledges give evidence of income available to repay them.

Pledges express your support and involvement in this community project.

How do I pay?

By cash or card in the church office; by cheque sent to the office; by online bank transfer; through www.stewardship.org.uk/pages/stgeorgesfatfieldfacility (a crowdfunding site); or by standing order.

Can my pledge be Gift Aided?

If you pay tax and sign a Gift Aid Declaration, your gifts are worth 25% more to the project.

Can I give a loan?

If you wish to discuss offering an interest-free loan then please contact the office or treasurer.

What is a pledge?

A pledge is a commitment to give money in the future, either on a one-off or regular basis.

Are pledges confidential?

Yes, only the treasurer, vicar and the person writing letters of acknowledgement will know the identity of people making pledges.

What if my financial circumstances change?

Any pledge can be increased or decreased at any time if your circumstances change.

Can I leave a gift in my will?

Yes, a legacy can be left in your will, however we cannot rely on these for near term funding. If you already have a will, you can add a 'codicil' to update it. If you would like a codicil form please ask.

How do you hope to raise the money?

We have already received two legacies of over £10,000 to fund the initial work and hope others will be equally generous. We are grateful for every gift, small or large. Whether a regular monthly gift or £25,000 in one go, every gift and pledge will make a difference. Once we receive over half of the total cost, we will be able to access many more external funders and trusts.
